Get you and your family into the nautical spirit and enter our origami boat contest.

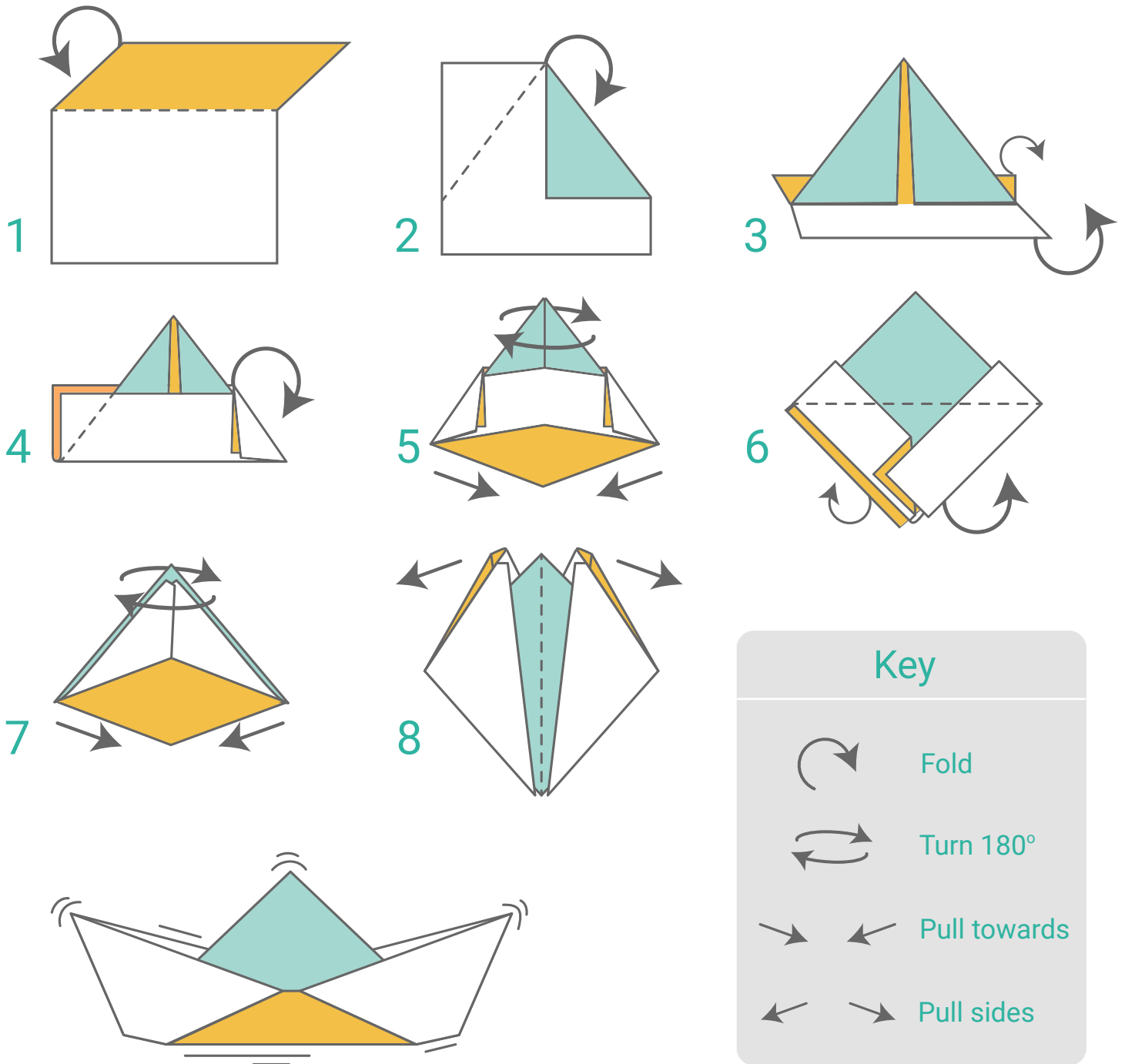
1. Grab a piece of A4 paper.

Instructions

1. Fold an A4 in half lengthwise with the crease at the top.
2. Fold in corners evenly into the centre.
3. Fold front and back rectangular edges up.
4. Fold corners in on side with the crease to make a triangle.
5. Pull the centre outward, turn 180° and flatten to make a square.
6. Fold front and back layers up to make a triangle.
7. Pull the centre outward, turn 180° and flatten to make a square.
8. Take upper corners, and stretch out to create the boat, finally mould to adjust.
